When documenting the equipment of deploying units during unit movements, the addition of a Unit Identification Code (UIC) will allow Army to correlate the UIC to the Transportation Control Number (TCN). In addition, the data will serve as a final validation of the Unit Deployment List (UDL) provided to the Integrated Data Environment/ Global Transportation Network (IDE/GTN) Convergence (IGC).

The goal of the IDE/GTN Convergence is to provide supply chain, distribution, and logistics information fusion through common integrated data and application services. To enable development of cohesive Command & Control (C2) and business decision solutions by and for the Combatant Commands (COCOMs), Services, Joint Staff, Agencies, and other Federal organizations.

Lastly, the Deputy Program Management Office – Concepts and Doctrine (DPMO-C&D), Ft Lee VA, concurs with the requirement as necessary to retain a consistent/ habitual relationship of the Unit Line Number (ULN), Transportation Control Number (TCN) and Line Item Number (LIN) to the unit movement data documented in 858B transactions.

The benefit of this action will enhance asset tracking and provide increased visibility of both unit and sustainment shipments during any type of movement.
