He provides direction and oversight on contracting policy, acquisition strategy development, and program management in support of national level strategic airlift, sealift, and surface mobility readiness programs. He is the acquisition program executive officer and serves as the milestone decision authority for assigned programs

Mr. Bartley is a retired Army Major General. He started his Army career by enlisting as an armor crewman. He attended the U.S. Military Academy Preparatory School and graduated from West Point in 1976. As a company and field grade officer he held numerous Armor and Cavalry command and staff positions from Platoon up to the Division level. His acquisition assignments cover every aspect of Life Cycle Management – requirements generation; design and development; test and evaluation; production and fielding. As a general officer he was engaged in acquisition and readiness programs from their inception to their execution. His last assignment was to design, stand-up and lead a new Program Executive Office whose mission was to reach across the Army with a mandate to guide the integration and interoperability of the Army's programs of record, current force systems, and other key elements.
