The Department of Defense's (DoD) Better Buying Power 3.0 initiative mandates defense agencies to increase productivity, efficiency, and effectiveness. USTRANSCOM's experienced acquisition workforce is carrying out this mandate by establishing best practices for acquiring Transportation and related services. Each acquisition is carefully reviewed to select the most appropriate contract type and determine the best acquisition strategy. Some factors considered are identifying "should cost" saving opportunities, schedule constraints, complexity of the requirement, contract/performance risk and industry capabilities.

When determining the acquisition strategy, we employ the full spectrum of the best value continuum to include Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA), Performance-Price Trade-off (PPTO) or Expanded Trade-off (ETO). The following table reflects the breakdown of the best value source selection strategies used FY2012, FY2013 and FY2014 for our major programs:

We will continue to foster a competitive environment and maximize dollars by awarding best value contracts at a reasonable price. Working in partnership with our customers and commercial service providers, we design innovative acquisition solutions resulting in greater efficiencies and increased industry productivity.

The declining defense budget and drawdown in operations has a corresponding downward trend in customer transportation requirements. Additionally, we've seen a change in customer's priorities within the procurement with regard to the best value determination. In FY14, TCAQ processed over 5,400 contract actions totaling \$4.1 billion dollars compared to FY13 when TCAQ processed over 4,900 contract actions totaling \$5.5 billion dollars and FY12 with over 6000 contract actions totaling \$7.8 billion. Our employment of best value strategies has remained constant over the last two years, with 21% utilizing an LPTA strategy. We anticipate the remainder of FY2015 will continue to reflect previous year's approaches.

The Acquisition Procurement Forecast is a tool for both large and small business entities to identify new and follow-on contract opportunities for transportation programs with a projected dollar value in excess of \$150,000. The forecast is to be used for informational purposes only; it does not constitute an offer or commitment to fund the opportunities referenced herein. This listing may not be all inclusive of all upcoming requirements.

The forecast is sorted by North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) codes. As requirements are subject to change without notice, they are not listed in date order.
