Description:

In the B4 Segment at Index 2-11, update the language as follows:

This is free-form text for the actual location of the B403 event. Format as follows:

a. For all shipment moves other than those occurring at an airport as part of a multimodal move described in para b below, provide [City] [State or Province] [GENC country code]. All 3 components are required and should be separated by a space. In cases where there is no State or Province, use "ZZ" for the State or Province code.

Example: "Norfolk VA US" (City State Country)

Example: "Dunkirk ZZ FR" (City (No Province=ZZ) Country)

b. When identifying airport locations as part of a multimodal move use the following format:

"[ICAO] [actual ICAO of the airport] [description of the airport]"; all 3 components are required and should be separated by a space. Use of this functionality is limited to shipments in and out of the Afghanistan Theater of Operations in support of Operation Enduring Freedom only.
 Example: "ICAO OOTH Thumrait AB Oman".

NOTE: If available, when the location is provided in the B411 a location qualifier and code will be provided in the N9 Segment – Reference Identification. See the N9 Segment Notes for additional instructions.

ITEM 4: REASON FOR CHANGE (business case)

Updates the description of the B411 Segment to address locations that have no State or Province. Addresses an ongoing data quality issue which doesn't allow for the State/Province to be Null. Refers to N9 Segment – Reference Identification, which will capture associated location codes (DODAAC, MILSTAMP, Census, ICAO, Zip Code).

08/12/2016 13:03:17 Ms. Sylvia Williams - DLMSO - Do not approve : The solution proposed doesn't seem to resolve the issue(s) this DM is intended to address. This DM proposes using a free-form text field (B411; 1/B411/020; DE) to convey formatted data, and delineates the formatting that must be used by senders. DLMSO has a small concern about requiring specific formatting in a free-form text field, but there are two specific objections to this proposed implementation: 1) The user note says "This is free-form text....format as follows....". These instructions are contradictory: I recommend that the submitter rephrase to eliminate "free-form text" from the user note. 2) The proposed use of the character as a delimiter will not work as described in these DMs. DM 1232 says that for a US city the formatting should be: CityStateCountry, however, the examples shown in DM 1235 show the following as a valid example of data to be conveyed in the B411: "Scott AFB IL US". Given the formatting rules in DM 1232, a translator would parse this data as City=Scott; State=AFB; Country=IL. Any city that has a two part name (e.g., New York City, Fort Belvoir, Newport News), will have this same problem and fail parsing. Secondly, because the B411 is declared as an alphanumeric data element in the X12 standard, it is not possible to enforce syntactic compliance in a commercial EDI translator.
