Although the DTEB support team may consider that "understood" in the DM change, EBSO would prefer to see it specifically called out in the DM change text. 2) Also, at one point in Item 3: Proposed Work in the DM the text refers to "the stackable/non-stackable flag", which is a misnomer. This is (as correctly identified elsewhere in the Item 3 text) only a "stackable" flag—if the shipment unit is not stackable, the iteration of the L11 segment containing this flag is not sent at all.
