MEETING MINUTES 19 September 2017

INTRODUCTION

The Defense Transportation Electronic Business (DTEB) Committee convened on 19 September 2017. The meeting was chaired by Mr. Jim DeCarli, DTEB Co-Chair, USTRANSCOM J6-C. Meeting facilitators were Mr. Mike James, DTEB Support, and Mr. Dan Eisenberg USTRANSCOM J6-C. Meeting attendance was recorded by the facilitators.¹

TECHNICAL SECRETARY REPORT (MR. JAMES)

X12 MEETINGS

- The last ASC X12 meeting was held 04 – 08 June, 2017, as a virtual meeting for all Transportation Subcommittee activities; minutes for all Transportation Subcommittee and task groups have not been posted to the [ASC X12 Inc.](#) website for review
- The next ASC X12 committee meeting is scheduled for 24 – 28 September 2017 as a standing meeting in Pittsburgh, PA

X12 MEETING SUMMARY

- X12I (Transportation) reviewed 17 data maintenance (DM) items
- DMs 021214 and 035215 were reviewed and approved for subcommittee referral
 - These DMs address the use of words such as “shall”, “should”, and “must” in X12 documents
- No significant progress was made on the code value decoupling issue in the X12I meeting
- Next X12 Meeting Issues:
 - Code value decoupling
 - X12-C has published a white paper on this issue, which will be discussed.
 - Further process for LAT/LONG maintenance
 - X12I – Transportation Subcommittee referred data maintenance

DFTS CONTRACT STATUS

- 03 Aug new protest submitted
- 30 Nov 17 current protest period ends
- DTCI 10 year limitation ends 15 Oct 17
- DTCI 1 year extension ends 15 Oct 18
- Work by the PM/SE IPTs, and DOD systems continues
 - Mr. Hudson informed the Committee that this involves:
 - Processing sites not on DTCI Contract
 - Stopping efforts just before making any shipments that would be covered by DTCI

DATA MAINTENANCE REVIEW

DM 1250

- Affected IC: 856A - Receipt/Shipment-Consolidation/Due-In/REPSHIP (4010)
- In the LQ01, DE1270, at index 96-01 change the DOD implementation note on code value '83' to read:
 - "Use '83' to denote Due-In Notice Supply Condition Code'."
- Status: Approved by NVR (no vote required)

DM 1251

- Affected IC: 214A - Motor Carrier Shipment Status (4010)
- In the L11 segment at index 21 change the segment condition note to read:
 - "SEGMENT CONDITION: Carriers are encouraged to provide either status location, SPLC, Aerial Port, or postal code data where available. This segment may occur once per shipment status event (LX Loop)."
- In the L1101, DE127, at index 21-01 change DOD implementation note to read: "SPLC, Aerial Port, or Postal Code (DG110)"
- In the L1102, DE128, at index 21-02 add the following X12 codes and DOD implementation notes:
 - Code value '4L - Location-specific Services Reference Number', DOD implementation note: "Use '4L' to denote International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) code of the location reported in the MS101 for events occurring at an airport"
 - Code value 'ZZ – Mutually Defined', DOD implementation note: "Use 'ZZ' to denote International Air Transport Association (IATA) code of the location reported in the MS101 for events occurring at an airport"
- Status: Approved by member vote 17 April 2017; implemented in 214A (4010)
Version 4

DM 1253

- Affected ICs: 219A – DTCI Transportation Service Request (4010), 219D - 3rd Party Logistics Transportation Service Request(4010)
- In the LH101, DE355, change the DOD implementation note to read:
 - Code specifying the units in which a value is being expressed, or manner in which a measurement has been taken. Contains the code identifying the Unit of Measure (type of packaging) for which the data in LH102 is reported. See Section 6 for a list of the LH101 supported codes (cross referenced from Type Pack Code passed in the LCT02, DE211).
- Use LH106 to express weight and volume for non-bulk shipments. Refer to the X12 Standard, DE355 for applicable codes. Remove the statement that reads:
 - If a particular element contains several valid values found in multiple tables within section six of an IC, the following entry would be made. Common code values associated with multiple definitions prevents documentation of the entire sub-set.
- In the LH106, DE355, remove all listed code values and change the DOD implementation note to read:
 - Use the unit of measure codes for quantity or volume of non-bulk shipments. This will typically be pounds, cubic feet, or a unit of measure other than pieces. Refer to the X12 Standard, DE355 for applicable codes. Use LH101 to express type of packaging. ELEMENT CONDITION: Required if LH107 is used.
- In Section 6, table for Type Pack Code and HAZMAT - Unit of Measure Code, correct indices in the table title and the column for LH101 Values to match the applicable index in sections 3 & 4.
- Status: Approved by member vote 10 April 2017; implemented in 219A Version 3, 219D Version 4

DM 1254

- Affected IC: 220D - 3rd Party Logistics Transportation Service Response (4010)
- In the ITA segment at index 10, flag the ITA04, DE331 as used, add DOD usage requirement of 'M' - Mandatory. Add DOD implementation note that reads:
 - Use code value 'ZZ' to satisfy X12 syntax requirements". Add code value 'ZZ - Mutually Defined'.
- Status: Approved by member vote 24 April 2017; implemented in 220D Version 4

DM 1255

- Affected IC: 858B- Transportation Control and Movement Document (TCMD) (4010)
- In the LFH02, DE809 at index 127-02 change DOD implementation note to read:
 - Enter the approved ANSI X12 code from TRDM (<https://trdmws.maf.ustranscom.mil/trdm/index.html#/TRDM/table/data/Type%20Pack%20American%20National%20Standards%20Institute%20Accredited%20Committee%20X12>)
- Status: Approved by NVR

OUSD(AT&L) DLMS COMPLIANCE IPT (MR. DECARLI)

Mr. DeCarli provided an update on the current status of the DLMS Compliance effort.

- OUSD is mandating compliance with DLMS standards
- Mr. DeCarli has been participating in the DLMS Compliance IPT on a biweekly basis.
- TMT tasking has identified that
 - USTANSCOM & Component Programs consume DLMS messages, but do not generate or send DLMS messages
 - DLA provides interpretation of DLMS messages for TRANSCOM consumption.
- Will continue to monitor DLMS implementation
- Mr. Payne informed the committee that a presentation of TRANSCOMs findings to the IPT has been suggested by the OUSD POC.

OPEN DISCUSSION

DM 1257, 1258

- Mr. Napoli inquired about the differing qualifier codes for the segments referenced in these two DMs.
 - Ms. Verdu and Ms. Campbell requested additional time to review the DMs and related ICs.
- ACTION ITEM: Follow up with SDDC representatives to aid in determining whether this will require an additional DM.

DFTS DMs

- Mr. Hudson informed the Committee that he will be working with DTEB support staff to submit DM(s) modifying the 219D and 220D.
- ACTION ITEM: Follow up with DFTS representative to aid in DM submission.

ACTION ITEM REVIEW

The committee was updated on the status of the following action items from the February 2017 meeting.

- 858B/M Personal Property Codes Coordination (AI # 2017001)
 - Status: In Progress
 - DTEB support staff to coordinate with FACTS and DLATS on support requirements for DTEB DM 1248 applied to the 858B and 858M for personal property shipment codes
 - Verify with DLATS and FACTS support requirements and ability of DM 1248.
 - 02 Mar 17 - email sent to DLATS and FACTS PMO requesting update on capability
 - FACTS representatives indicates this can be closed
 - DTEB staff will follow up with DLATS

- ACTION ITEM: DTEB support staff to follow up with SDDC representatives to aid in determining whether an additional DM will be required for 1257 & 1258 codes mismatch.
- ACTION ITEM: DTEB support staff to follow up with DFTS representative to aid in DM submission for 219D and 220D.
