


Common Operating Picture (COP) Deployment and Distribution (D2)

Project Summary: Project to mitigate the effect of multiple, overlapping functional legacy systems and business processes, & provide timely, relevant and actionable information to enhance the warfighters' level of confidence in joint distribution processes. Benefits include increased capability to respond quickly to changing operational environments; identify best alternative when unplanned events occur; increased customer satisfaction; and increased



responsiveness and operating velocity due to the improved ability to manage inventory, assets and processes.

Return on Investment: As the COP D2 matures through its near-term, midterm, and long-term spiral deliverables, it will continually reduce the time spent by the logistician manually aggregating and correlating information in order to see snapshots of the D2 operational picture; effectively improving warfighter operational efficiency. As COP D2 matures through its spiral implementation, it will provide the integration of functionality such as TRANSVIZ into the warfighters' operational framework, incorporate maturing commercial Business Intelligent tools into the warfighters' tool kit; and enhance the warfighters' ability to resolve bottlenecks, optimize movement lift, etc.
