


<u>Cross Domain Collaborative Information Environment for Common Operating</u> <u>Picture (COP) Deployment and Distribution (D2)</u>

Project Summary: The Cross Domain Collaborative Information Environment will enable Combatant Commands to share information in the form of chat, whiteboarding, and web services between DoD and non-DoD networks of various classifications, to include coalition partners, other governmental agencies, and nongovernmental organizations. These capabilities must be available to the full spectrum of partners, from highly trusted coalition classified networks, to low/no trust computers or networks.



Return on Investment: The capabilities that the Cross Domain Collaborative Environment develops would provide dynamic, flexible, and threat-tailorable solutions for exchanging information between security domains, ultimately improving the effectiveness of the JFC Commander. This capability shows promise for publishing and calling web services across security domains (i.e., from NIPR to SIPR, and vice versa).
