Prior to her current assignment, she served as Commanding General, 143d Sustainment Command (Expeditionary), Orlando, Florida. She has three deployments to Iraq and Kuwait in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Freedom's Sentinel, Operation Inherent Resolve, and Operation Spartan Shield.

She has served in several joint positions to include assignments at the Defense Logistics Agency, North East Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Defense Logistics Agency, Fort Belvoir, Virginia; and at the Headquarters Deployment Distribution Operations Center, Kuwait.

Her awards include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal, the Parachutist Badge, and Air Assault Badge.
