4. Document Changes (400NG, IT, and TOS): All changes and updates will be in red text for additions and strikethrough for deletions. Business rules will go into effect 15 May 2022 – 14 May 2023 or until USTRANSCOM publishes new documents superseding the 2022 Business Rules.
