Subject: Ever Given vessel blocking traffic at Suez Canal

1. On 26 March, USTRANSCOM was notified of Ever Given vessel blocking traffic at the Suez Canal. We request for all International TSPs provide a status update only for shipments potentially affected transiting the Suez Canal. Provide updates using the following information:

- a. Provide GBL#
- b. Estimate Time of Arrival (ETA) to ultimate destination
- c. If any shipments affected, update DPS under In-transit status notes and General Remarks
- d. Negative response is not required

2. PPPO counselors, please be aware that privately owned vehicles (POV) transiting the Suez Canal from Bahrain and Turkey may also be impacted by the waterway blockage. If you receive customer inquiries requesting POV status, please refer the member to International Auto Logistics' (IAL) Customer Service toll-free telephone line at (855) 389-9499.
