## **ESTIMATED TIME OF ARRIVAL (ETA) CODES**

The ETA code is used by shippers to indicate the number of days a shipment will be in transit from the consignor to a port of embarkation (POE). Using the ETA code and the date shipped code, the POE is able to determine when the shipment will arrive. The most current ETA codes are available on the USTRANSCOM Reference Data Management System website at <a href="https://trdmws.maf.ustranscom.mil/">https://trdmws.maf.ustranscom.mil/</a>— click on "DTR Data" and "Estimated Time of Arrival Domain", and select "Display Data" from the Action Legends box.
