## VESSEL SUSTAINING CODES (VOYAGE ITINERARY POINT SELF SUSTAINABILITY CODE)

## A. GENERAL

The vessel sustaining code indicates the physical capability of the ship's gear to discharge the cargo on board regardless of the vessel terms of carriage. This code is used only on the ocean manifest header cards.
