## **APPENDIX W**

## NON-DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DOD) USE OF THE DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (DTS) AIRLIFT, SEALIFT, AND GROUND (TRUCK/RAIL) APPROVAL PROCEDURES

## A. GENERAL

This appendix provides Transportation Offices (TOs) and logistics activities detailed information pertaining to transportation requests for non-DoD agencies use of the DTS. DoD transportation resources may be used to move non-DoD traffic only when the DoD mission shall not be impaired and movement of such traffic is of an emergency, lifesaving nature, specifically authorized by statute, in direct support of the DoD mission, or requested by the head of an Agency of the Government pursuant to Sections 1535 and 1536 of 31 United States Code (U.S.C.) (commonly referred to as the Economy Act). Economy Act requests for surface (truck/rail) support is executed in accordance with Service/Component guidance. For airlift and certain surface request support see <a href="Table W-2">Table W-2</a>. Airlift, sealift, and ground (truck/rail) approval authority for movements that **are not** primarily of official interest to the DoD Component concerned are vested with the Secretary of Defense or designee as prescribed in Department of Defense Directive (DoDD) 4500.09, <a href="Transportation and Traffic Management">Traffic Management</a>, Enclosure E4.3., and Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 4500.57, <a href="Transportation and Traffic Management">Traffic Management</a>. The delegations of that approval authority and points of contact (POCs) are reflected in the following tables.
