





Reference Block 11a. This contract requires access up to SECRET information. Due to SECRET information or data within a government controlled space, the primary contractor and all supporting contract personnel must possess a SECRET Security Clearance granted by Defense Industrial Security Clearance OFFICE (DISCO) before access will be granted to classified area, information, or documents. SECRET will not be released to contractor employees without specific release approval of the originator. Prior approval and certification of need-to-know shall be obtained from the appropriate Program Manager or designated Contract Monitor (CM), on all such releases. SECRET materials furnished in support of this contract remain the property of the US Government User Agency that released it. Upon completion or cancellation of the contract, SECRET materials previously furnished will be returned to the direct custody of the agency having cognizance unless other disposition instructions have been issued. All personnel requiring access to Government personnel working in a classified environment or working with, or in a work area containing SECRET data shall possess a minimum SECRET clearance. The contractor shall comply with all appropriate provisions of applicable security regulations. Contractor shall ensure changes in assigned and accepted personnel shall comply with security clearance requirements. To ensure cognizance of, and adherence to, security classification regulations, the Contractor and Contractor personnel will comply with all applicable DOD 5220.22-M National Industrial Security Program Operating Manual (NISPOM), DOD 5220.22 Industrial Security Regulation, United States Air Force, United States Transportation Command, and Scott Air Force Base Directives and Instructions.
