SUBJECT: Request for Proposal (RFP) Information Resource Management Data Repository (IRMDR) Tool Suite (HTC711-08-R-0016)


1. It is the intent of USTRANSCOM to award a labor hour, sole source 8(a) commercial contract in accordance with FAR Sub-Part 19.8 to provide contractor support services for the Information Resource Management Data Repository (IRMDR) Tool Suite . The Performance Work Statement (PWS) (Attachment 1) details the effort to be accomplished. The period of performance for IRMDR is from 1 June 2008 through 30 September 2008, with two one-year option periods.
2. A response to this request shall consist of:
 - a. Brief Technical Approach and Staffing Plan
 - b. Priced Proposal
3. To result in a contract award, your proposal must meet all minimum technical requirements and conform to all required terms and conditions. The following factors will be used to evaluate your proposal:
 - a. Technical capability offered to meet the Performance Work Statement (PWS) requirement.
 - b. Strong background and expertise in an Oracle environment using Cold Fusion
 - c. Experience with, but not limited to, Cold Fusion, SQL*Plus, JAVA, NetViz, WinSCP, Erwin, Siteminder, and Access
 - d. Experience in obtaining Government Authority to Operate (ATO) security accreditation
 - e. Experience in performing software loads, troubleshooting local personnel computer technical problems, and knowledge of processing Government requests for purchase of hardware and software buys
 - f. A working functional knowledge of defense transportation data
 - g. Price
4. The Government reserves the right to obtain information relative to present and past performance on its own. If you are aware that one or more of your contracts in the Contractor

Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) specifically relates to the requirements in this acquisition, please provide this information.

5. Cost/price proposal shall be in a format that reflects the number of labor hours and labor categories proposed. Your overall price for performance of this specific PWS requirement will be evaluated for completeness and reasonableness considering the proposed approach in terms of labor or skill mix, labor hours, any other direct costs. GSA pricing or better is requested.

6. It should be noted that there is no obligation on the part of the Government to make an award in response to this request. It is our intent to evaluate your proposal and award without discussions; however, we reserve the right to hold discussions.
