1. CONTRACTING ACTIVITY:

United States Transportation Command, DPO Support Division, USTRANSCOM/TCAQ-D, 1900W, Scott Drive, Building 1961, Scott AFB IL 62225-5357.

2. NATURE AND/OR DESCRIPTION OF ACTION BEING APPROVED:

Defense Personal Property System (DPS) Joint Program Management Office (JPMO) requires other than full and open competition that specifies a brand name product for several versions of Oracle database software licenses to support the Joint Program Management Office (JPMO) HHGS, Defense Personal Property System (DPS) production environment suite at the United States Transportation Command, Scott AFB IL 62225-5357. This action will result in a firm-fixed price delivery order under Enterprise Software Initiative (ESI).

3. DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED TO MEET THE AGENCY'S NEEDS:

The JPMO requires renewal of the Oracle software license as part of the DPS production environment suite from 21 September 2013 through 30 September 2014. This renewal is necessary to receive software subscription support and to obtain the latest updates and security patches required for the DPS authority to operate. 4. AUTHORITY AND SUPPORTING RATIONALE:

In accordance with FAR 8.405-6(b)(1), consideration is restricted to a brand name item peculiar to one manufacturer. The purchase of the Oracle software license is essential to the Government's requirements. Installing other than Oracle software licenses will invalidate the security of the Production Environment Servers, resulting in a loss of DPS authority to operate within any Government network. JPMO determined that similar products cannot be modified to meet the agency's need.

5. DETERMINATION BY THE CONTRACTING OFFICER THAT THE ORDER REPRESENTS THE BEST VALUE CONSISTENT WITH FAR 8.404(d):

This determination has been made by comparison of commercial product prices published in GSA Advantage schedule contracts, which have already been determined to be fair and reasonable by GSA. Based on this approach, the Contracting Officer concluded that a fair and reasonable price is available. To maximize competition for this effort, posting the requirement to the GSA eBuy website is in the best interest of the Government.

6. DESCRIPTION OF THE MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED, AND THE RESULTS OR A STATEMENT OF THE REASON MARKET RESEARCH WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

Market research was conducted via the internet. The Government searched the DOD ESI website and GSA schedules to identify available options for this software licenses and support. Other software and support is available; however, they do not satisfy the requirement because they do not mirror the software in use in the DPS production environment. It was also determined these Oracle products were available on the DOD ESI website from seven (7) vendors: Immix Group, Mythics, Affigent LLC, Alliance Technology Group, LLC, Dynamic Systems, Inc., Sterling Computers Corporation and DLT Solutions. This requirement will be posted on GSA eBuy and interested offerors will have fair opportunity to submit an offer.
