1. CONTRACTING ACTIVITY.

United States Transportation Command, DPO Support Division, USTRANSCOM/TCAQ-D, 508 Scott Drive, Building 1900W, Scott AFB, IL 62225. The EDO contract was a competitive order issued under GSA provisions.

2. NATURE AND/OR DESCRIPTION OF ACTION BEING APPROVED.

USTRANSCOM/TCJ6-S requires continued support from the "Enterprise Data Office, Information Management & Validation" (EDO) contract. USTRANSCOM/TCJ6-S requires other than full and open competition for EDO Support from DRC. The contract was originally awarded on 13 Dec 2010. Earlier during the execution of this contract, a base period, two option years, and a 6-month contract extension period were executed. There were two additional option years (FY 14 and FY15, under FAR 52.217-9) that were not exercised by the Government due to contract re-compete, which is now under protest, necessitating this new 11-week contract extension. This additional eleven (11) week period of performance is required to allow resolution of the protest and completion of the source selection for this new contract. The addition of an eleven (11) week period of performance will being issued by modification to the current contract as a mutual agreement of both parties IAW FAR 52.212-4(c) Changes. This document provides the Command's Limited Source Justification.

3. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES REQUIRED TO MEET THE AGENCY'S NEEDS.

The purpose of this requirement is to ensure the EDO continues to support USTRANSCOM Data Management requirements. Any lapse in EDO support will have an immediate impact on USTRANSCOM and the Department of Defense.

It is in the best interest of the Government to have the existing vendor, Engility, continue this support for the eleven (11) week extension. Any other vendor would not have enough ramp-up time to become effective. The estimated time to acquire a new contractor, and for them to

possess the fundamental knowledge level required to support this effort is approximately 6-9 months.

Engility was the original contractor performing the work under the current task order. The total estimated value of adding a eleven (11) week period of performance is The period of performance for this task order will be extended from 1 April 2014 to 14 June 2014.

4. AUTHORITY AND SUPPORTING RATIONALE FOR LIMITING SOURCES

FAR 8.405-6(a)(1)(i)(C) - In the interest of economy and efficiency, the new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule order.

The original order was placed in accordance with the applicable Federal Supply Schedule ordering procedures. The original order was not issued under sole-source or limited-sources procedures.

This eleven week extension is necessary in order to finalize an ongoing competitive best value source selection for a replacement contract. Award of the replacement contract has been delayed due to a pre-award bid protest. USTRANSCOM requires continued EDO support until a new contract can be awarded. The tasks required during the extension period are identical to those currently being performed. Even if it were possible to obtain identical support for such a short term through competition, it would be uneconomical and inefficient to do so.
