#### JUSTIFICATION FOR OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION

Enterprise Architecture Support to Portfolio Management and the Corporate Services Vision Environment, Contract HTC711-12-C-D002

#### 1. CONTRACTING ACTIVITY.

United States Transportation Command, DPO Support Division, USTRANSCOM/TCAQ-D, 508 Scott Drive, Building 1900W, Scott AFB, IL 62225-5357.

### 2. NATURE AND/OR DESCRIPTION OF ACTION BEING APPROVED.

USTRANSCOM/TCJ6-S requires continued contract support for the "Enterprise Architecture (EA) Support to Portfolio Management and the Corporate Services Vision Environment" contract. This contract will be replaced by a combined contract that will include EA, Data, and Engineering for AMC, SDDC, and USTRANSCOM. The combined contract has a pre-award protest that will not be decided until 1 April 2014. The IDIQ and task orders that will provide the required services for the subject effort are expected to start on 15 June 2014. The previous six (6) month extension of service period to the current contract expires on 31 March 2014. Therefore, USTRANSCOM/TCJ6-S requires other than full and open competition for EA from TRIDENT3 to add an additional eleven (11) weeks to the existing contract to avoid a break in support.

### 3. <u>DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES REQUIRED TO MEET THE AGENCY'S NEEDS.</u>

The purpose of this requirement is to ensure the Enterprise Architecture (EA) continues to support Portfolio Management and the Corporate Services Vision Environment. Any lapse in EA support will have an immediate impact on USTRANSCOM and the Department of Defense.

It is in the best interest of the Government to have the existing vendor, TRIDENT3, continue this support for an additional eleven (11) weeks. Any other vendor would not have enough ramp-up time to become effective. The estimated time required to bring a new contractor on-board and up to the fundamental knowledge level required to support this effort is approximately 6-9 months.

TRIDENT3 is the original contractor performing the work under the current contract. The total estimated value of adding an eleven (11) week period of performance is

The period of performance for this task order will be extended from 1 April 2014 to 14 June 2014.

# 4. <u>IDENTIFICATION OF THE STATUTORY AUTHORITY PERMITTING OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION.</u>

10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1) or 41 U.S.C. 253(c)(1). Only One Responsible Source and No Other Supplies or Services Will Satisfy Agency Requirements.

An additional eleven (11) weeks of support is urgently needed to avoid a break in support. TRIDENT3 is the only responsible source capable of providing continued service without significant rampup time and a break in service is unacceptable to the Government. This additional support is being entered into by mutual agreement of both parties.

### 5. <u>DEMONSTRATION OF THE PROPOSED CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE</u> <u>QUALIFICATIONS TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED SUPPLY OR SERVICE.</u>

The current contractor (TRIDENT3) has expertise in converting USTRANSCOM architecture documents into the same format and terminology used by SDDC and AMC, and inserting the new information into a consolidated architecture tool currently used by SDDC and AMC. USTRANSCOM has only recently directed this activity. Bringing on a different contractor for only an eleven (11) week extension would not allow enough time for them to familiarize themselves with this new process nor make any progress in completing the activity.

## 6. <u>DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS MADE TO ENSURE THAT OFFERS ARE SOLICITED FROM AS MANY POTENTIAL SOURCES AS POSSIBLE.</u>

Other offers were not solicited for this eleven (11) week period due to the unexpected requirement for an extension. Additionally, there would not be enough time for a different contractor to gain the knowledge needed for current activities, which are specific to USTRANSCOM.

## 7. <u>DETERMINATION BY THE CONTRACTING OFFICER THAT THE</u> <u>ANTICIPATED COST TO THE GOVERNMENT WILL BE FAIR AND REASONABLE.</u>

The Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) and Contracting Officer will review the proposal. The contractor should utilize the current labor categories on contract, which were determined to be fair and reasonable through a competed acquisition. In the event that labor rates are escalated, the Government will review the percentage utilized for the escalation to determine if the percentage used is fair and reasonable in the marketplace.

### 8. MARKET RESEARCH.

Additional research was not conducted for this eleven (11) week extension period.
