Status of the JIWG SC

- **Last meeting was held at LOGSA PSCC, Tobyhanna, PA, 11 Aug 10**
 - There are no pertinent requirement(s) to convene the next SC meeting
- **Items of interests:**
 - MIL-STD-3028, JMIC
 - ISO TC 104, Containers
 - Conversion of MIL-HDBK-138 to MIL-STD-3037

MIL-STD-3028 - JMIC

- **MIL-STD is active as of 6 Jul 09**
- **NATO Combat Service Support Supply Panel**
 - **NATO CSS SP meeting held 17-21 Oct 11**
 - Nations agreed to incorporate JMIC criteria (2nd version) in STANAG 2828
 - LOGSA PSCC, as custodian, will incorporate the new annex in the next revision of STANAG 2828 (circa May 12)
 - **Capable Logistician Exercise 2013**
 - LOGFAS, ADAMS, OLCM
 - Impact on empty container management, FMS, etc.

ISO TC 104

- **ISO TC 104, Freight containers (SC1)**
 - US TAG Administrator: Material Handling Industry of America
 - USTRANSCOM serves as DOD proxy to ISO TC 104
 - LOGSA PSCC serves as standardization interface with JIWG SC and interested STDZN offices

TC 104 Actions

- **ISO 6346, Freight containers - Coding, identification and marking**
 - DOD issue: need to identify containers with reduced stacking or racking capabilities
 - LOGSA PSCC e-msg sent 22 Aug 11
 - Containers with reduced stacking or reduced racking strength shall have size type code marks on the front (blind end) and on the roof at either end
 - Expected revision Dec 11
- **ISO 830, Terminology**
 - DOD proxy reaffirmed ISO 830. There are no supporting changes to the document, 2 Sep 11

TC 104 Actions (cont'd)

- **ISO 1496-2, Series 1 freight containers - Specification and testing, Part 2: Thermal containers (systematic review of)**
 - No comments were surfaced to DOD proxy, 19 Sep 11
- **ISO 1496-5, Series 1 freight containers - Specification and testing, Part 5: Platform and platform-based containers (systematic review of)**
 - No comments were surfaced to DOD proxy, 19 Sep 11

TC 104 Actions (cont'd)

- **ISO 17712, update on tamper-evident testing for mechanical security seals**
 - No comments were surfaced to DOD proxy, 24 Oct 11
 - May have broader interest to DoD container community
- **ISO/DIS 1496-1, Series 1 freight containers -- Specification and testing, Part 1: General cargo containers (ballot)**
 - Received USN PHST essential comments
 - DOD comments due 15 Nov 11

Conversion of MIL-HDBK-138 to MIL-STD-3037

- Purpose
- Standardization activities

Purpose

- **Convert MIL-HDBK-138B to MIL-STD-3037 so that it can be incorporated into contracts with commercial container leasing companies/ocean carriers, as appropriate. Align the new MIL-STD inspection criteria for commercial dry cargo containers with accepted commercial industry criteria of the International Institute of Container Lessors (IICL).**

Standardization Activities

- **Lead Standardization Activity: LOGSA PSCC**
- **Preparing Activity: ARDEC**
- **Army Custodian: ARDEC**
- **Navy Custodian: Naval Sea Systems Command (Ship Systems)**
- **Air Force Custodian: HQ Air Force Materiel Command**
- **Defense Logistics Agency Custodian: n/a**
- **Acts as Agent for the MIL-STD: Defense Ammunition Center**

Actions Completed

- **DAC, as Technical Agent, prepared and submitted a preliminary draft to ARDEC, 18 Aug 11**
- **ARDEC, as the Preparing Activity, ensured the document was compliant with MIL-STD-962, 31 Aug 11**

Actions Completed (cont'd)

- A writing team meeting was conducted at ARDEC, 8-9 Sep 11, to prepare the 1st informal coordination draft of MIL-STD-3037
 - **Participants included ARDEC, DAC, SDDC AIDPMO, and LOGSA PSCC**
- Substantial progress was made on the coordination draft
- MIL-STD-3037 would be titled "Inspection Criteria for International Organization for Standardization (ISO) Containers"
 - **Several issues remain open**
 - Discussion to follow

Actions to Address

- **Draft MIL-STD-3037 (98% complete)**
- **Business Case Analysis Partner with Industry (as a starting point –**
- **DoD proxy/US TAG to ISO TC 104, etc.)**

- ARDEC to finalize coordination draft
- LOGSA PSCC to submit coordination draft to SC and primary stakeholders
- Writing team to review comments and finalize 1st draft
- ARDEC to submit 1st draft in ASSIST
- ARDEC to obtain LSA, Custodians, and Review Activities concurrence
- Submit BCA to ASE for review and approval
- ARDEC to submit final draft and approval memo to DAPS
